Who are we?


- Grassroots, 501(c)3, non-profit, all volunteer





Affect on Salmon (and other fish) from Excessive Exports








California Almond-Bearing Acreage

2002-2012




California Almond Forecast (May 3, 2012)

Tunnel Plan


The State talks about how their plan is to go "under" the Delta

But each 60'x150' shaft site indicates a massive construction project





Construction sites all through the center of the South Delta will block boating and recreation for eleven years



South Delta Water Quality

After the tunnels are in, what would the water quality be in Discovery Bay and South Delta waterways?

ANSWER: Salty, stagnant, more toxic algae

That's bad for boating, bad for local farms and golf courses, and bad for fish.

ANSWER: It's bad, bad, bad

The current plan needs to be stopped or needs significant changes – and that's what we're working for.
